The 21-day period has now 20 21 expired, and plaintiff has not filed a response. 22 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice. See Local Rule 110; Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b). 23 24 These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge 25 assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Within fourteen after 26 being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written objections with 27 the court. The document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and 28 Recommendations." Plaintiff is advised that failure to file objections within the specified time 1
