

1 in fees under the Equal Access to Justice Act (“EAJA”). (ECF No. 31 at 4.) Thereafter, plaintiff
2 filed a reply requesting “leave to amend the motion to \$12,500.” (ECF No. 32 at 2.)

3 Plaintiff’s request will be granted. Plaintiff’s amended motion shall be sure to clarify the
4 amount requested and how that amount relates to the 25% statutory cap. See Gisbrecht v.
5 Barnhart, 535 U.S. 789, 802 (2002).

6 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 7 1. Plaintiff’s request to file an amended motion is granted;
- 8 2. Counsel for plaintiff shall file an amended fee motion within twenty-eight days of the
9 date of this order; and
- 10 3. Defendant may file an opposition or statement of non-opposition within fourteen days
11 of the date of filing of plaintiff’s amended fee motion.
