24	Nettles v. Grounds, 830 F.3d 922, 936 (9th Cir. 2016). Petitioner will be provided an opportunity	
25	to file a complaint stating all his claims as against all defendants in a single operative pleading.	
26	Petitioner is cautioned that failure to file a complaint within the time specified herein may result	
27	in dismissal of the entire action. See Local Rule 110.

7	4. Petitioner shall file a complaint within 30 days of the date of this order; and

9	complaint for prisoner civil rights cases.
