Good 22 cause appearing, both motions will be granted, and the dates to complete discovery and to file 23 pretrial motions will be adjusted as stated herein. 24 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. Plaintiff's motion for relief from default for late service of discovery documents (ECF 25 26 No. 41), is GRANTED; 27 2. Defendants' motion to modify the discovery deadline and to extend their time to 28 respond to plaintiff's written discovery requests (ECF No. 42) is GRANTED; 1

8	before December 1, 2022.
