25	3. Plaintiff's written discovery requests shall be limited to twenty-five requests for	
26	admissions per defendant; ten requests for production per defendant, and twenty-five	
27	interrogatories per defendant;

1	4. Plaintiff's written discovery requests shall be limited in scope and time frame to 2013	
2	to 2018, and they must pertain to his claims in the operative complaint;	
3	5. Defendants' deadline to serve responses and objections to plaintiff's written discovery	
4	requests is extended up to and including October 31, 2022.	
5	6. The remaining relevant motion dates in the court's discovery and scheduling order	
6	(ECF No. 38) are RESET as follows:	
7	a. Any motions to compel discovery shall be filed by November 28, 2022, and	
8	b. All pretrial motions, except motions to compel discovery, shall be filed on or	
9	before February 20, 2023.	
10	All other directives in the court's discovery and scheduling order issued February 15,	
11	2022 (ECF No. 38), are to remain in full force and effect.
