Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding through counsel with an action under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff challenges the use of the Guard One security system at various prisons where he has been incarcerated. On November 29, 2018, plaintiff, acting in pro per, filed a document entitled “Emergency Preliminary Injunction Request.” (ECF No. 172.) Therein, plaintiff complains about the prison’s deduction of court fees from his trust account.¹


