

1 all applicable law. Local Rule 183(a). Failure to comply with applicable rules and law may be
2 grounds for dismissal or any other sanction appropriate under the Local Rules. Id.

3 In light of plaintiffs' pro se status, and in the interests of justice, the court will provide
4 plaintiffs with an opportunity to show good cause for their conduct along with a final opportunity
5 to oppose defendants' motions.

6 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

7 1. Plaintiffs show cause in writing within fourteen days of the date of this order as to why
8 this case should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution¹;

9 2. The May 18, 2018 hearing of defendants' motions to dismiss (ECF Nos. 16 & 20) is
10 continued to **Friday, June 22, 2018, at 10:00 a.m.**, at the United States District Court, 501 I
11 Street, Sacramento, California, in Courtroom No. 27, before the undersigned;

12 3. On or before **June 8, 2018**, plaintiffs shall file a statement of opposition or non-
13 opposition to defendants' motions to dismiss; and

14 4. Plaintiffs are cautioned that the failure to timely comply with this order may result in a
15 recommendation that this case be dismissed.
