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On May 4, 2018, Defendants State of California, Governor Edmund G. Brown Jr., in his official capacity, and Attorney General Xavier Becerra, in his official capacity (the "State"), filed an opposition to Plaintiff United States of America's Motion for Preliminary Injunction (ECF No. 74) and a Motion to Dismiss (ECF No. 77). The United States' Opposition to the State's Motion to Dismiss is due on June 6, 2018 (ECF No. 79) and its Reply in support of Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction is due on June 8, 2018 (ECF No. 41). The State's Reply in support of its Motion to Dismiss is due on June 13, 2018 (ECF No. 79). The hearing for both motions is set for June 20, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. (ECF Nos. 41, 79).

In addition, on May 14, 2018, the Supreme Court issued a decision in *Murphy v. National Collegiate Athletic Ass'n*, No. 16-476, 584 U.S. __ (May 14, 2018), which the State believes is relevant to the issues in this matter and presented in the pending motions. In light of the foregoing, and for the parties to efficiently brief the pending motions and to address the significance of *Murphy*, if any, the parties hereby stipulate and agree to the following briefing schedule and supplemental briefing:

- 1. The State will be allowed to file a five-page supplemental brief discussing the significance of *Murphy* on or before May 25, 2018.
- 2. The United States will be allowed an additional five pages for its Reply in support of Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction to reply to any arguments raised by the State in its supplemental pleading.
- 3. The United States will be allowed an extension of time to file its Opposition to the State's Motion to Dismiss, up to and including June 8, 2018, the same date that its Reply in support of Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction is due.
- 4. The State will be allowed an extension of time to file its Reply in support of Defendants' Motion to Dismiss, up to and including June 15, 2018.
