ORDER

On May 9, 2019, plaintiff filed an “emergency motion for evidentiary hearing. . . .” (ECF No. 46.) Plaintiff’s motion crossed in the mail with this court’s May 8, 2019 order. Thus, there is no need for a hearing, and any complaint plaintiff has concerning his current conditions of confinement in Terre Haute, Indiana, must be brought in an appropriate court in Indiana.
