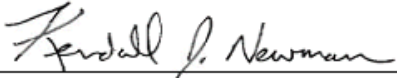
In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

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2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send petitioner a copy of the in forma pauperis form used by this district.
