See Doc. 6. On June 27, 2018, and June 28, 21 2018, Petitioner filed objections and requested the action be recharacterized as a civil rights 22 action under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. See Docs. 7 and 8. In the interest of justice, and at the request of Petitioner, the June 19, 2018, findings and recommendations will be vacated and the action will 23 24 be recharacterized as a civil rights case. See Nettles v. Grounds, 830 F.3d 922, 936 (9th Cir. 25 2016). Petitioner will be provided an opportunity to file a complaint stating all his claims as 26 against all defendants in a single operative pleading. Petitioner is cautioned that failure to file a

complaint within the time specified herein may result in dismissal of the entire action. See Local

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The findings and recommendations issued on June 19, 2018, are hereby vacated; 2. This action is recharacterized as a prisoner civil rights action; 3. The Clerk of the Court is directed to update the docket to reflect this action proceeds as a prisoner civil rights action under 42 U.S.C. § 1983; 4. Petitioner shall file a complaint within 30 days of the date of this order; and 5.
