23	The failure of a party to comply with the	he Local Rules or any order of the court "may be	
24	grounds for imposition by the Court of any and all sanctions authorized by statute or Rule or		
25	within the inherent power of the Court." Local Rule 110. Any individual representing himself or		
26	herself without an attorney is bound by the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Local Rules, and		
27	all applicable law. Local Rule 183(a). Failure to comply with applicable rules and law may be		
28	grounds for dismissal or any other sanction appropriate under the Local Rules. Id.

1	In light of plaintiff's pro se status, and in the interests of justice, the court will provide	
2	plaintiff with an opportunity to show good cause for plaintiff's conduct along with a final	
3	opportunity to comply with the December 30, 2019 order.	
4	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
5	1. Plaintiff show cause in writing within fourteen days of the date of this order as to why	
6	this case should not be dismissed for lack of prosecution ¹ ;	
7	2. The January 31, 2020 status conference is continued to Friday, February 21, 2020, at	
8	10:00 a.m., at the United States District Court, 501 I Street, Sacramento, California, in	
9	Courtroom No. 27, before the undersigned;	
10	3. On or before February 7, 2020, plaintiff shall file a status report;	
11	4. On or before February 14, 2020, defendant shall file a status report; and	
12	5. Plaintiff is cautioned that the failure to timely comply with this order may result in a	
13	recommendation that this case be dismissed.
