19	application to proceed in forma pauperis or pay the filing fee for this action. Plaintiff was advised	
20	that failure to comply would result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed. The	
21	fourteen days has passed, and plaintiff has not complied with the court's order.	
22	In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be	
23	dismissed without prejudice.	
24	In light of those recommendations, IT IS ALSO HEREBY ORDERED that all filings	
25	in this action are STAYED pending resolution of the findings and recommendations. With the	
26	exception of a completed application to proceed in forma pauperis, objections to the findings and	
27	recommendations, and any non-frivolous motions for emergency relief, the court will not	
28	entertain or respond to any motions and other filings until the findings and recommendations are

1 resolved.

2	These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge	
3	assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within fourteen (14)	
4	days after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written	
5	objections with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Such a document should be captioned	
6	"Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Any reply to the objections	
7	shall be served on all parties and filed with the court within fourteen (14) days after service of the	
8	objections. Plaintiff is advised that failure to file objections within the specified time may waive	
9	the right to appeal the District Court's order. <u>Turner v. Duncan</u> , 158 F.3d 449, 455 (9th Cir.	
10	1998); Martinez v. Ylst, 951 F.2d 1153, 1156-57 (9th Cir. 1991).	
11	IT IS SO ORDERED AND RECOMMENDED.
