2 requests for the necessary paperwork.<sup>1</sup>

3 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

4 1. Plaintiff's motions for preliminary injunction (ECF Nos. 4, 5) and motion for  
5 help (ECF No. 10) are construed as motions for an extension of time to file an application to  
6 proceed in forma pauperis.

7 2. Plaintiff's motions for an extension of time (ECF Nos. 4, 5, 9, 10, 11) are granted.

8 3. Plaintiff is granted thirty days from the service of this order in which to file a  
9 completed in forma pauperis application. If plaintiff is unable to comply with this order, he must  
10 submit to the court a copy of his request for a copy of his certified trust account statement along  
11 with any responses received from jail officials. Failure to comply with this order may result in  
12 dismissal.

13 4. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff a new Application to Proceed In  
14 Forma Pauperis By a Prisoner.

15 5. The Clerk of the Court shall serve a courtesy copy of this order on Lieutenant Ramos at  
16 the Sacramento Main Jail, 651 I Street, Sacramento, CA 95814.
