No objections were filed. 19 The Court has reviewed the applicable legal standards and, good cause appearing, 20 concludes that it is appropriate to adopt the proposed Findings and Recommendations in full. 21 Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that: 22 1. The proposed Findings and Recommendations filed September 10, 2019, (ECF No. 26) are ADOPTED; 23 2. Defendants' motion to dismiss (ECF No. 17) is GRANTED in part and DENIED in 24 25 part as follows: 26 Defendants' motion is GRANTED as to plaintiff's substantive due process 27 and equal protection claims, and these claims are dismissed without leave to 28 amend; and

1	b. Defendants' motion is DENIED as to plaintiff's First Amendment retaliation
2	claim.
