The Court has reviewed the applicable legal standards and, good cause appearing, concludes that it is appropriate to adopt the proposed findings and recommendations in full.


Accordingly, IT IS ORDERED that:

Failure to timely file an amended complaint in accordance with this Order will result in a recommendation by the magistrate judge that this action be dismissed.
