20 Office of the Attorney General filed a response by special appearance explaining why plaintiff	
was temporarily deprived of his property, but stating that plaintiff received his property on April	
2 28, 2020. (ECF No. 37 at 2.) Counsel provided a copy of the receipt reflecting plaintiff received	
six boxes of property on April 28, 2020. (ECF No. 37 at 5.)	
On May 4, 2020, plaintiff's request for extension of time addressed to the Court of	
Appeals for the Ninth Circuit was opened as a new habeas case. <u>Howard v. Peiffer</u> , No. 2:20-cv-
