ORDER

Petitioner is a state prisoner proceeding pro se with a mixed petition for a writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. On April 18, 2019, the court granted petitioner thirty days to file a request for a stay, or alternatively to file an amended petition listing only exhausted claims. ECF No. 16. Petitioner has failed to file his motion for a stay or an amended petition within the requisite deadline.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that petitioner shall show cause, in writing, within 14 days, why this matter should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute and/or to follow a court order pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b). The filing of motion for stay or an amended petition within this timeframe will serve as cause and will discharge this order.
