ORDER

Plaintiff is a California prisoner proceeding pro se with a civil action. On May 29, 2018, the court ordered plaintiff to either submit a request to proceed in forma pauperis or pay the filing fee. However, the court recently learned that plaintiff is not permitted to proceed in forma pauperis because he has “struck out” pursuant to Title 28 U.S.C. § 1915(g), Bonilla v. Lively, 4:11-cv-3180 CW (N.D. Cal. Oct. 25, 2011), and he does not allege he is under “imminent danger of serious physical injury.”



Failure to pay the filing fee within 14 days will result in dismissal.
