Plaintiff has submitted the 19 affidavit required under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(a)(1), which 20 demonstrates that Plaintiff is unable to pay fees or security. 21 Plaintiff's Motion to Proceed In Forma Pauperis is therefore 22 23 granted. The Clerk of the Court is directed to issue forthwith all 24 process pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4. The Clerk 25 of Court shall send plaintiff five USM-285 forms, one summons, 26 and a copy of the complaint. Plaintiff is advised that the U.S. 27 Marshal will require: (1) one completed summons; (2) one 28

completed USM-285 form for each defendant; (3) a copy of the complaint for each defendant; and (4) a copy of this order.

The U.S. Marshal shall serve process without prepayment of costs. The Clerk of Court shall serve a copy of this order on the United States Marshal, 501 "I" Street, Sacramento, CA 95814 (tel. 916-930-2030).
