**ORDER & WRIT OF HABEAS CORPUS
AD TESTIFICANDUM**

Charles Faultry, CDCR # G-31037, a necessary and material witness in a settlement conference in this case on November 12, 2020, is confined in California State Prison Sacramento (CSP-SAC), in the custody of the Warden.
