No objections were 20 filed. Accordingly, the court presumes that any findings of fact are correct. See Orand v. United 21 States, 602 F.2d 207, 208 (9th Cir. 1979). The magistrate judge's conclusions of law are 22 reviewed de novo. See Britt v. Simi Valley Unified School Dist., 708 F.2d 452, 454 (9th Cir. 23 1983). 24 The court has reviewed the applicable legal standards and, good cause appearing, 25 concludes that it is appropriate to adopt the findings and recommendations in full. 26 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The findings and recommendations (ECF No. 140) are **ADOPTED** IN FULL; 27 28 2. Plaintiffs' Motion for Default Judgment (ECF No. 130) is **GRANTED**; 1

1	3. Plaintiffs are awarded final judgment in the amount of \$3,340,256; and
2	4. Candle3's counterclaims (ECF No. 59) are DISMISSED WITH PREJUDICE pursuant to
3	Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b) for failure to prosecute.
