ORDER

Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed this civil rights action seeking relief under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.

On July 23, 2020, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which were served on plaintiff and which contained notice to plaintiff that any objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Plaintiff has not filed objections to the findings and recommendations.

The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by the magistrate judge’s analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The findings and recommendations filed July 23, 2020, are adopted in full; and

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2. This action shall proceed on the following claims: (1) a First Amendment retaliation claim against Dr. Michelle DiThomas and Registered Nurse (“RN”) Harris, (2) an Eighth Amendment medical indifference claim against Dr. DiThomas, RN Harris, Dr. Pai, Dr. Joseph Bick, and Dr. Lotersztain, and (3) a state law medical malpractice claim against Dr. DiThomas, RN Harris, Dr. Pai, Dr. Bick, Dr. Lotersztain, Dr. Dhillon, and Dr. Trimbur.

3. All remaining claims and defendants are hereby dismissed.

4. Case to remain open.
