That 60-day period has now expired, and plaintiff has not 20 filed an amended complaint or otherwise responded to the court's order. Plaintiff has consented 21 to this court's jurisdiction pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(c) and Local Rule 302. 22 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice. See Local Rule 110; Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b). 23 24 These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within fourteen days 25 26 after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written objections 27 with the court. The document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings

and Recommendations." Plaintiff is advised that failure to file objections within the specified
