26	court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper

2	1. The findings and recommendations filed April 9, 2021, ECF No. 32, are adopted in

4	2. Plaintiff's claims against defendants Reece, Laufik, Ichimaru, Snyder, Smith, and	
5	Lozano are dismissed without leave to amend for failure to state a claim
