Riley ("claimant"), appearing in propria persona, as follows: 1. On or about January 31, 2018, claimant filed a claim in the administrative forfeiture 21 22 proceeding with the U.S. Postal Inspection Service with respect to the Approximately \$5,100.00 in U.S. Currency and Approximately \$4,400.00 in U.S. Currency (hereafter "defendant currency"), which were 23 seized on November 29 and 30, 2017. 24 25 2. The U.S. Postal Inspection Service has sent the written notice of intent to forfeit required by 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(1)(A) to all known interested parties. The time has expired for any person to file a 26 claim to the defendant currency under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(2)(A)-(E), and no person other than claimant 27 has filed a claim to the defendant currency as required by law in the administrative forfeiture proceeding. 28

- 3. Under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the United States is required to file a complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture within ninety days after a claim has been filed in the administrative forfeiture proceeding, unless the court extends the deadline for good cause shown or by agreement of the parties. That deadline is May 1, 2018.
- 4. As provided in 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the parties wish by agreement to extend to May 31, 2018, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture.
- 5. Accordingly, the parties agree that the deadline by which the United States shall be required to file a complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture shall be extended to May 31, 2018.
