ORDER

Plaintiff filed his second request for an extension of time to file objections to the February 21, 2020 findings and recommendations, and also filed a motion to stay these proceedings. Plaintiff states that due to the current COVID-19 pandemic, California Health Care Facility is on modified program since March 18, 2020. Such program deprives plaintiff of law library access, which means he is unable to use the ADA word processor, and can only access legal authorities by using the paging system. Good cause appearing, plaintiff's request for an extension of time is granted. In light of such lengthy extension, no stay of this action is required at this time. Plaintiff is cautioned that he is granted an extension of time to file objections to the findings and recommendations, not to further seek leave to amend. Plaintiff has previously filed amended complaints, and the court is not inclined to grant plaintiff further leave to amend in this action. Fed. R. Civ. P. 15(a).


