(ECF No. 112.) Plaintiff 23 24 filed objections to the findings and recommendations. (ECF No. 119.) Plaintiff also filed a 25 request for judicial notice concurrently with the objections. (ECF No. 120.) 26 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this 27 Court conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the //// 28 1
