FINDINGS AND RECOMMENDATIONS

By an order filed June 19, 2020, this court ordered plaintiff to complete and return to the court, within sixty days, the USM-285 form necessary to effect service on defendant Sanchez. (ECF No. 51.) Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that defendant Sanchez be dismissed without prejudice. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b).

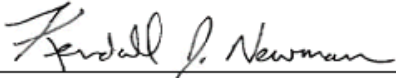
