20	On June 28, 2023, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which		
21	were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the		
22	findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Defendants filed objections		
23	to the findings and recommendations.		
24	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this		
25	Court has conducted a <i>de novo</i> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the		
26	Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper		
27	analysis.		
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1		Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
2	1.	The findings and recommendations filed June 28, 2023 (ECF No. 60) are ADOPTED IN
3		FULL;
4	2.	Defendants' motion for summary judgment is GRANTED in part, as to Plaintiff's claims
5		against Defendant Mutopo, and DENIED on all grounds asserted as to Defendants
6		Dacuycuy and Hortizuela; and
7	3.	This case is referred back to the assigned magistrate judge for further pretrial proceedings.
