For the reasons stated in that order, the undersigned recommends dismissal 20 of plaintiff's conspiracy claim brought pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1985(3). 21 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that the conspiracy claim raised in the 22 amended complaint be dismissed. 23 These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge 24 assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Within fourteen days after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written objections 25 26 with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Such a document should be captioned 27 "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Plaintiff is advised that

failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the right to appeal the District
