The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge 19 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On October 17, 2019, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein 21 which were served on plaintiffs and which contained notice to plaintiffs that any objections to the 22 findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Plaintiff Young has filed 23 objections to the findings and recommendations. 24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this 25 court has conducted a de novo review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the 26 court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper 27 analysis. 28 1

2	1. The findings and recommendations filed October 17, 2019, are adopted in full;
3	2. The motions for class certification (ECF Nos. 5 & 10) are DENIED;
4	3. All class action claims are DISMISSED without prejudice; and
5	4. Young's individual claims are DISMISSED without prejudice.
