23	IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:	
24	1. Within fourteen (14) days of this Order, the	
25	parties shall contact the court's VDRP administrator, Sujean	
26	Park, at (916) 930-4278 or SPark@caed.uscourts.gov, to start the	
27	process of selecting an appropriate neutral. The parties shall	

carefully review and comply with Local Rule 271, which outlines

the specifications and requirements of the VDRP.

- 2. Any party that objects to this referral to the VDRP shall file its objections within seven (7) days of this Order. Such objections shall clearly outline why that party believes that the action is not appropriate for referral to the VDRP.
- 3. To avoid the unnecessary expenditure of costs and attorneys' fees, this action is hereby stayed to provide the parties time to complete the VDRP session. No later than five (5) days after completion of the VDRP session, the parties shall file a joint statement indicating whether a settlement was reached.
- 4. The parties shall complete the VDRP session no later than December 13, 2019. The court hereby resets the Status (Pretrial Scheduling) Conference for January 21, 2020 at 1:30 p.m. in Courtroom 5 (WBS). If a settlement is not reached through VDRP, the parties shall submit an Amended Joint Status Report no later than January 7, 2020.
