18	with the court on July 24, 2019. The court's own records reveal that on May 16, 2019, plaintiff	
19	filed a complaint containing virtually identical allegations. (Harris v. Jerry Brown, No. 2:19-cv-	
20	0311 KJM CKD P (E.D. Cal.). <sup>2</sup> Due to the duplicative nature of the present action, the court will	
21	recommend that the complaint be dismissed.	
22	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is directed to assign	
23	a district judge to this case; and
