ECF No. 29. 18 Plaintiff was granted thirty days to file an amended complaint. Id. at 4-5. Instead of filing an 19 amended complaint, plaintiff filed a motion asking that he be permitted to stand on the allegations 20 in the second amended complaint. ECF No. 30. Alternatively, he requests a thirty-day extension 21 of time to file a third amended complaint. *Id.* Since the second amended complaint's allegations 22 fail to state a claim, see ECF No. 29, the court will grant plaintiff's alternative request for an 23 extension of time. 24 Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that: 25 1. Plaintiff's motion for an extension of time, ECF No. 30, is granted. 26 2. Plaintiff may file an amended complaint on or before January 4, 2021. 27 3. Failure to file an amended complaint by that date will result in a recommendation that 28
