ORDER

On February 7, 2022, plaintiff filed a motion for reconsideration of the magistrate judge’s order filed January 19, 2022, granting defendant’s motion to modify the discovery and scheduling order and granting defendant thirty days to file a motion to compel. Pursuant to E.D. Local Rule 303(f), a magistrate judge’s orders shall be upheld unless “clearly erroneous or contrary to law.” Id.
