**ORDER**  
VACATING THE STATUS CONFERENCE  
AND DIRECTING PLAINTIFF TO FILE AN  
UPDATED ADDRESS  
RESPONSE DUE WITHIN FOURTEEN  
DAYS

Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se in an action brought under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. After the court resolved all dispositive motions, this matter was set for trial before the Honorable Daniel J. Calabretta. ECF No. 65. Since then, plaintiff has sought two lengthy extensions of time. ECF Nos. 67 & 70. In the interest of advancing this case, the court determined that it would be beneficial to vacate the trial dates and hold a status conference, set for February 8, 2024. ECF No. 71.

However, the court is compelled to vacate the status conference as plaintiff's address appears to be invalid. The court is aware of three ostensibly accurate addresses for plaintiff: the address plaintiff provided to the court, Kern Valley State Prison, 3000 West Cecil Avenue, Delano CA 932116; the address plaintiff listed in most recent filing, "G.B.D.F -M/OBS 102 #1


1 451 Riverview Pkwy Bldg 'C' Santee, CA 92071," ECF No. 72; and plaintiff's address according  
2 to the California Incarcerated Records and Information Search, California Institution of Men,  
3 14901 Central Avenue, Chino, CA 91710, *see* California Incarcerated Records and Information  
4 Search, <https://apps.cdcr.ca.gov/ciris/details?cdcrNumber=V72307> (last visited February 6,  
5 2024). Because the court cannot accurately locate plaintiff to setup the video conference for the  
6 hearing, the February 8, 2024 hearing is vacated and plaintiff is ordered to file an updated address  
7 with the court within fourteen days.

8 Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that:

- 9 1. The February 8, 2024 status conference is vacated.
- 10 2. Plaintiff is ordered to file an updated address with the court within fourteen days.

11 IT IS SO ORDERED.
