20	On March 19, 2020, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein

23	objections to the findings and recommendations.	
24	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this

26	Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper	
27	analysis.

2	1. The findings and recommendations filed March 19, 2020, (ECF No. 12) are

4	2. The petition (ECF No. 1) is DISMISSED for failure to state a cognizable claim;	
5	3. Petitioner's Motion to Amend (ECF No. 15) is DENIED as moot;	
6	4. The Clerk is directed to close the case; and	
7	5. The court declines to issue a certificate of appealability.
