
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1 fourteen (14) days preceding the noticed . . . hearing date." Defendant, however, has failed to file 2 a timely opposition or statement of non-opposition. 3 The failure of a party to comply with the Local Rules or any order of the court "may be 4 grounds for imposition by the Court of any and all sanctions authorized by statute or Rule or 5 within the inherent power of the Court." Local Rule 110. Any individual representing himself or 6 herself without an attorney is bound by the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, the Local Rules, and 7 all applicable law. Local Rule 183(a). Failure to comply with applicable rules and law may be 8 grounds for dismissal or any other sanction appropriate under the Local Rules. Id. 9 In light of defendant's pro se status, and in the interests of justice, the court will provide 10 defendant with an opportunity to show good cause for defendant's conduct along with a final 11 opportunity to oppose plaintiff's motion. 12 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 13 1. Defendant show cause for defendant's conduct in writing within fourteen days of the 14 date of this order; 15 2. The October 16, 2020 hearing of plaintiff's motion for preliminary injunction (ECF 16 No. 26) is continued to Friday, November 13, 2020, at 10:00 a.m., at the United States District 17 Court, 501 I Street, Sacramento, California, in Courtroom No. 27, before the undersigned; 18 3. On or before October 30, 2020, defendant shall file an opposition or statement of non-19 opposition to plaintiff's motion; 20 4. Defendant is cautioned that the failure to timely comply with this order may result in 21 the appropriate sanction; and 22 5.
