The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate 19 Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On March 29, 2023, the magistrate judge issued findings and recommendations herein 21 which were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to 22 the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. (ECF No. 14.) 23 Petitioner has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. (ECF No. 15.) 24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this 25 Court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the 26 Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper 27 analysis. 28 /// 1

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The findings and recommendations issued March 29, 2023 (ECF No. 14), are ADOPTED IN FULL; 2. Respondent's motion to dismiss (ECF No. 11) is GRANTED; 3.
