The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge 20 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 21 On October 5, 2023, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein 22 which were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Plaintiff filed objections 23 24 to the findings and recommendations. In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this 25 26 Court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the 27 Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper 28 analysis. 1

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The findings and recommendations filed October 5, 2023 (ECF No. 57) are ADOPTED IN FULL; and
- 2. Plaintiff's motion to reopen his case (ECF No. 55) is DENIED.
