 31 IT IS STIPULATED by and between Plaintiff (“Plaintiff”) and Defendant Andrew Saul,
 32 Commissioner of Social Security (“Defendant”), through their undersigned counsel of record,
 33 that the above-entitled action shall be remanded to the Commissioner of Social Security for
 34 further administrative proceedings.

35 Upon remand, the Office of Hearing Operations will remand the case to an
 36 Administrative Law Judge (ALJ) for a new decision, and instruct the ALJ to re-evaluate the
 37 evidence of record. The parties further request that the Court direct the Clerk of the Court to
 38 enter a final judgment in favor of Plaintiff, and against Defendant, reversing the final decision of

1 the Commissioner.

2 This stipulation constitutes a remand under the fourth sentence of Section 205(g) of the
3 Social Security Act, 42 U.S.C. 405(g).
