ORDER

Plaintiff, proceeding *pro se*, filed the above-entitled action. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to Local Rule 302(c)(21).

On January 4, 2022, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the findings and recommendations were to be filed within twenty-one days. (ECF No. 129.) Neither party has filed objections to the findings and recommendations.¹

The Court has reviewed their filing. However, as the Magistrate Judge stated, their “statements as non-parties do not alter the outcome” of this action. (ECF No. 129 at 35.) Moreover, the Court previously explained that Michael Jacobs may not represent Kingdom in this matter. (*See* ECF No. 48.)

3 1. The findings and recommendations filed January 4, 2022, are adopted in full;


4 2. Plaintiff's November 4, 2021, motion for default judgment, (ECF No. 126) is
