2	1. The Findings and Recommendations filed January 21, 2021 (ECF No. 27), are	
3	ADOPTED IN FULL;

10	with prejudice;	
11	b. Plaintiff's ADA and § 1983 claims against Yolo County, City of Woodland

26	f. Plaintiff's claim for a declaratory judgment is DISMISSED without prejudice;

2	Second Amended Complaint that complies with the requirements of the Federal Rules
3	of Civil Procedure, the Local Rules, and the Findings and Recommendations filed
