24	that defendant acted with deliberate indifference." (Doc. No. 78 at 8.) The pending findings and		
25	recommendations were served on the parties and contained notice that any objections thereto		
26	were to be filed within fourteen (14) days after service. (Id.) No objections to the findings and		
27	recommendations have been filed, and the time in which to do so has now passed.
