18	before the Court is Defendant's motion to compel, ECF No. 41, and Plaintiff's motion for an	
19	extension of time, ECF No. 50. Both motions are unopposed.	
20	In his motion to compel, Defendant argues that Plaintiff has not served responses	
21	to written discovery requests. See ECF No. 41. Defendant's counsel has filed a declaration in	
22	support of Defendant's motion indicating that, as of the date the motion to compel was filed, no	
23	responses to discovery had been received from Plaintiff. See id. at 10-11. Plaintiff has filed a	
24	motion for an extension of time to obtain medical records responsive to Defendant's discovery	
25	requests. <u>See</u> ECF No. 50.

1	Good cause appearing therefor, the Court will grant Defendant's unopposed	
2	motion to compel and Plaintiff's unopposed motion for an extension of time to provide discovery	
3	responses.	
4	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED as follows:	
5	1. Defendant's unopposed motion to compel, ECF No. 41, is granted.	
6	2. Plaintiff's unopposed motion for an extension of time, ECF No. 50, is	
7	granted.	
8	3. Within 30 days of the date of this order, Plaintiff shall serve responses to	
9	Defendant's first set of interrogatories and first set of requests for production of documents.	
10	4. Briefing on Defendant's motion for summary judgment remains suspended.	
11	5. Within 30 days after service of Plaintiff's responses to outstanding	
12	discovery requests, Defendant may file a new motion for summary judgment, a motion to re-open	
13	discovery, or a notice that Defendant intends to stand on the currently pending motion for	
14	summary judgment.
