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17	Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed this civil	
18	rights action seeking relief under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was	
19	referred to a United States Magistrate Judge as provided by 28	
20	U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.	
21	On February 22, 2022, the magistrate judge filed findings and	
22	recommendations, which were served on plaintiff and which	
23	contained notice to plaintiff that any objections to the findings and	
24	recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Plaintiff has	
25	filed objections to the findings and recommendations.	
26	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § $636(b)(1)(C)$	
27	and Local Rule 304, this court has conducted a <i>de novo</i> review of	
28	this case. Having reviewed the file, the court finds the findings and $\frac{1}{1}$	
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recommendations to be supported by the record and by the proper analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The findings and recommendations filed February 22, 2022, are adopted in full; 2. Plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis (ECF No. 9) is denied; and 3. Plaintiff is ordered to pay the \$402 filing fee within fourteen days from the date of this order and is cautioned that failure to do so will result in the dismissal of this action.
