The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge as provided 19 by 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On September 1, 2021, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations, which 21 were served on plaintiff and which contained notice to plaintiff that any objections to the findings 22 and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Plaintiff has filed objections to the 23 findings and recommendations. In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this 24 25 court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having reviewed the file, the court finds the 26 findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by the proper analysis. ///// 27 ///// 28 1

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. The findings and recommendations filed September 1, 2021, are adopted in full; 2. The First Amendment claims against defendants Muñoz and Allison are dismissed without leave to amend; 3. This case is proceeding on the Eighth Amendment excessive force claim against defendant Munoz; and 4. This case is referred back to the assigned magistrate judge for further pretrial proceedings.
