The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 19 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On June 13, 2022, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which 21 were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the 22 findings and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. (ECF No. 46.) Plaintiff has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. (ECF Nos. 47, 48.) 23 24 In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this 25 Court has conducted a de novo review of this case. 1	analysis.
2	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

5	2. Defendant Lainez is DISMISSED pursuant to Fed. R. Civ. P. 4(m).
