The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to Eastern District 20 of California local rules. 21 On October 18, 2021, the Magistrate Judge filed findings and recommendations herein 22 which were served on the parties and which contained notice that the parties may file objections within the time specified therein. (ECF No. 19.) Timely objections to the findings and 23 24 recommendations have been filed. (ECF No. 20.) In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304(f), this 25 26 Court has conducted a *de novo* review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the 27 Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper 28 analysis. 1

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. The findings and recommendations filed October 18, 2021, (ECF No. 19), are adopted in full;
- 2. Plaintiff's motion for leave to proceed in forma pauperis, (ECF No. 12), is denied; and
- 3. Plaintiff shall pay the full filings fees for this action within 30 days of the date of this order.
